

Crush Live Call-ins #560 4-6-26

Hand 1:

SETUP: Graton CA, \$3-5 8 handed, \$1keff

PRE: +1 \$25, LJ, BTN call, Hero 3! Qc Qh \$130, f/f, BTN calls. \$310

FLOP: Ks 6s 5c Hero bets \$125, BTN calls. \$560

TURN: 2s Hero x, BTN x. \$560

RIVER: 8d Hero X, BTN bets \$450, Hero folds. No reveal.

Hand 2:

SETUP: Texas card room 1-2 \$500 max. \$1300eff w +2, +1 has \$465

PRE: +1 \$15, +2 calls, Hero MP Qd Qh 3! \$75, +1 and +2 call. \$225

FLOP: Th 9s 7c x/x Hero bets \$60, +1 and +2 call. \$405

TURN: 4d x/x Hero bets \$125, +1 calls, +2 c/raises \$300, Hero calls, +1 jams for \$330 total, +2 calls, Hero calls. \$1395

RIVER: 2h +2 all-in \$800 Hero folds. +2 shows 85o.. +1 K8ss

Hand 3:

SETUP: MGM DC.. 1-3NL \$500 max. \$1250eff \$1-3-6

PRE: UTG \$25, BTN calls, SB calls, Hero in STRD Jc Jh 3! \$125, +1 calls, f/f. \$300

FLOP: Td 7h 4s .. Hero \$125.. +1 calls. \$550

TURN: 2c Hero bets \$300 +1 jams \$1,000, Hero folds face up +1 shows 98dd

Hand 4: Non hand call from Nate

BACKGROUND: "Hero" is in Seat 9, a winning pro. Seat 1 is clearly a recreational player. Seat 1 is constantly acting out of turn, not allowing the "Hero" to act.

SITUATION: Hand goes down where EP from S4 opens for a raise, "Hero" overcalls BTN and S1 in the SB calls. Flop comes out where Hero flops a set. S4 cbets \$25. The Hero in S9 notices that once again S1 is going to call out of turn (without allowing the Hero to act) and times it so that he puts in a massive raise of \$600 at the same time S1 puts in his out of turn call of \$25. Apparently at the room that they are playing in S1 is forced to put in the entire \$600 as a call, he has no option and not just \$25---Bart and Nate discuss if this is an angle and whether or not this behavior is appropriate for a winning player vs a huge rec, even though it might be within the rules.
